Announcement of the Science Camp Kappeln: Marine research for young students of Baltic Sea countries

Within the framework of the EU funded project „South Baltic WebLab“ scientists and technicians from the Leibniz Institute for Baltic Sea Research Warnemünde (IOW), the Technical University of Denmark (DTU) and the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (IO PAN) get prepared for a Science Camp with pupils. This camp will be jointly run with the UNESCO „Baltic Sea Project“) and takes place September 2-6 in Kappeln, northern Germany.

More than 100 students and its accompanying teachers from almost all Baltic Sea countries participate. This initiative aims to attract young people at an early stage for this challenging field of science. Project partners have prepared attractive offers ranging from short lectures, applying of eLearning modules, hands-on experiments and sampling onboard the IOW workboat “Klaashahn” to investigation of the derived samples.
