### **Announcement: “South Baltic WebLab“ joins the „South Baltic Edutainment Event“ in Danzig, September 18th, 2013**

*“South Baltic WebLab“ as an example for a cross-border activity to attract pupils to science*

In 2010 the Leibniz-Institute for Baltic Sea Research Warnemuende (IOW) established a network called the “South Baltic WebLab“ consisting of 7 marine and 2 computer science institutions from the South Baltic region aiming to attract pupils to marine science applying different approaches. Our project has been now selected as one of 17 projects to present results derived of EU-funded projects in the frame of the European Co-operation Day 2013.

The „South Baltic Edutainment Event“ provides the opportunity to display some of the outputs to school students aged 16-19 from Denmark, Lithuania and Poland. Scientists from the IOW and the Institute for Oceanology Polish Academy of Science (IOPAN) jointly present workshops where students get introduced into the eLearning modules and hands-on offers addressing relevant topics of Baltic Sea research.
