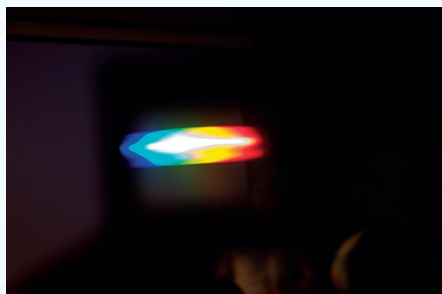




Meet researchers and listen to popular science stories about everything from Dark Materia, Evil Chemistry and Artificial Intelligence to the History of the Baltic Sea.
